 are your works, O Lord! The earth is full of your riches.

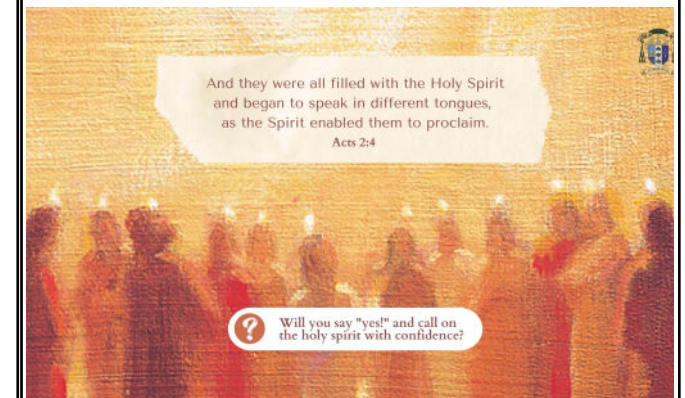
You take back your spirit, they die, returning to the dust, from
