1st Reading: Is 50: 4-7

Psalm: 21: 8-9, 17-20, 23-24

My God, My God, why have you abandoned me?.

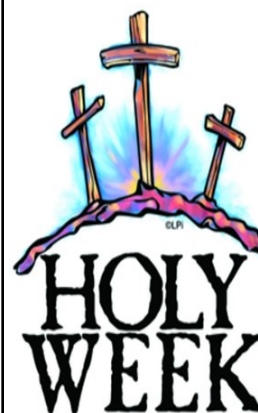
Diocesan Events

We would love you, your family, and your faith community to join us in this powerful public witness through the streets of Auckland.
