It is the Lord who grants favours to those to those whom he loves; the Lord hears me whenever I call him.

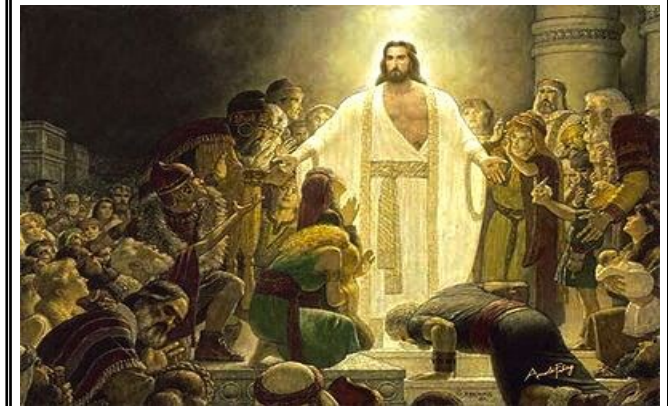
'What can bring us happiness?' many say. Lift up the light of your face on us, O Lord.
