**Psalm:** Ps 117:2-4,3-15,22-24: **Give thanks to the Lord for he is good, his love is everlasting.**

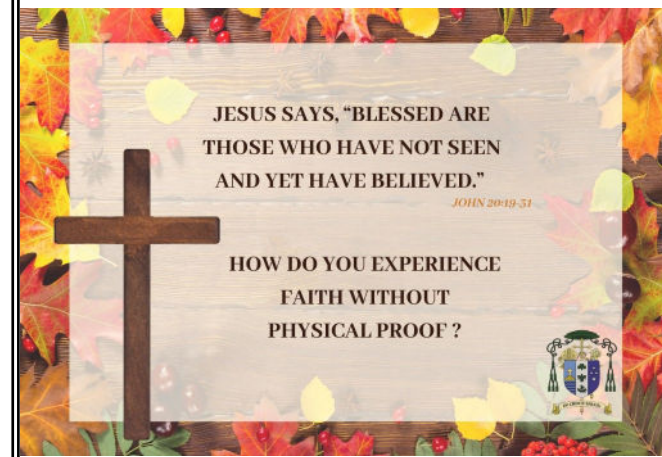
